**Interactive Classrooms Project in New South Wales**

I will be speaking about the Interactive Classrooms Project in NSW. In particular I will focus on the opportunities to support both core curriculum learning and extension opportunities using distance education technologies with a strong focus on video conferencing and desktop collaboration tools – this will include how teachers are developing and using content on IWBs. My focus will be on the impact these technologies are having on learning and teaching across the NSW DET.

I will present some examples of how learning technologies are currently being used in NSW, some examples of collaborative learning projects built around VC we have developed over the last 12 months and show some video clip examples of students and teachers from our schools using this equipment to support their learning. I will also talk a little about how teachers are collaborating using the technology to support their own professional learning
